## ISLAMIC STUDIES/QURAN

السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ وَرَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ وَبَرَكَاتُهُ

Alhamdulillah we started the year learning about the meaning of the Islamic greeting 'assalamu alaykum' (السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ) and its importance. We're learning about manners and phrases that Muslims should apply & say such as bismillah & alhamdulillah. We learned the concept of du'a & memorized the du'a for waking up.

We began the unit "Allah سبحانه و تعالی is my Lord & the Creator", we covered a name of Allah (Al-Ahad) and we'll continue learning about some of His characteristics through His 99 names.

### Qur'aan & Noraniyyah :

Alhamdulillah, we're practicing surat Al-Fatihah, Al-Ikhlās & Al-Ma'oothatayn, we started the first lesson of Noraniyyah focusing on recognition of the letters and the proper pronunciation of each letter (Al-makharij).

### The Weeks Ahead:

In Quran: we'll continue practicing surat Al-Fatihah, Al-Ikhlās & Al-Ma'oothatayn.

Noraniyyah: lesson # 1 (Hurouf Al-Hija').

Islamic studies: Allah سبحانه و تعالی is my Lord & the Creator.
