What you can do at home:

Our class will be focusing on different jobs that people have in the community. Children will read stories and learn about the tools and equipment that workers use.

Word Workout

Vocabulary: equipment, uniform Brainstorm some different kinds of workers in your community. Encourage your child to tell about the equipment a worker uses and the uniform a worker wears.

My Words to Know High-Frequency Word:

With your finger, spell out the word you on your child's arm. Next, encourage your child to think of a sentence that includes the word you. Write it down.

Phonics: o Help your child think of words that begin with or include the letter o. Then ask your child to underline the letter o in each word.

Comprehension: Have your child look closely at the pictures of different kinds of workers. Ask your child to describe details that tell about the uniforms or clothing these workers wear and the tools or equipment they use.

IN THE CLASSROOM!

In Language Arts, we are blending letters P, M, I, A, S, T and C. For example m-a-p. We are writing our sentences with a capital letter at the beginning and a period at the end.

In Math, we have been focusing on numbers 0-10. Numbers go in order. We can use a number line to help us see the order. We also learned what ordinal numbers are.

In Social Studies, we have been talking about America. What are the American symbols and what do they mean? What is the role of the president?

In Science, we know what natural resources are and how we can take care of the earth.
