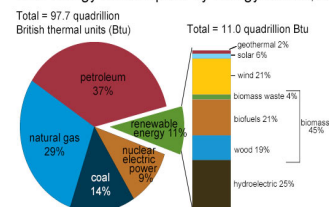
Science

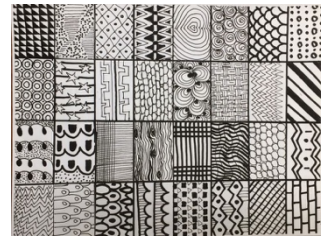
This month we will continue with our novel study, Grenade.
