What you can do at home
with ELA.

Our class will be reading stories about baby animals. Children will be using words to describe how the appearance and behavior of these animals are alike and different.

Here are some activities that you can do with your child to help reinforce the skills we will be practicing.

Word Workout

Vocabulary: appearance, behavior Discuss the appearance and behavior of a kitten, as well as other baby animals.

My Words to Know

High-Frequency Words: for, have Write sentences about baby animals using the words *for* and *have*. Read the sentences together. Ask your child to underline the words *for* and *have*.

Category Words: animal parts

Play "Guess the Animal." Give clues about an animal's appearance. Encourage your child to guess the name of the animal and act out how it moves.

Phonics: u Write the word *bug* on paper and sound out the word together. Then have your child think of other short *u* words that rhyme with *bug*, such as *dug*, *jug*, *hug*, and *mug*.

Comprehension: compare and contrast

Have your child sort the animals according to whether the animals can fly, swim, or run. Then encourage your child to tell the other ways these animals are alike and different.
