Memorize the red "Ahmar" and pink "Wardi" in Arabic

Understand classroom rules and how to follow them

Learn their names in Arabic

Express some feeling in Eid greeting words (Eid Saeed)

Then every day we discuss the calendar and the weather in Arabic
